

Summer Reading Assignment—12th Grade

Dear Parents:

Research shows that the frequency of reading plays a significant role in reading level retention. Therefore, we encourage students to read throughout the summer.

Assignment:

- *Jesus Among Other Gods—Youth Edition* by Ravi Zacharias and Kevin Johnson (ALL students)
- *The Screwtape Letters* by C.S. Lewis (honors only)

All 12th grade students will read *Jesus Among Other Gods—Youth Edition* by Ravi Zacharias and Kevin Johnson, and honors students will also read *The Screwtape Letters* by C.S. Lewis. During the first 90-minute class period, students will take a comprehension test on the novel(s). This test grade will be worth a 50-point grade for the 1st quarter.

In addition to the summer reading test, students will be required to complete a processed writing based on the summer reading assignment. This writing assignment will be completed during the first two weeks of school. Additional information will be given when the school year begins.
